## Member Unaccompanied Guests – Guidelines

Welcome to Little Frankston!

Here are a few guidelines to help maximise your enjoyment of the facilities and ensure that both the clubhouse and the course are left as you would wish to find them.

### Before Play

- Sign the visitor register in the hallway, pay green fees, place introductory letter in the slot and ensure bag tag is clearly visible on your golf bag

### On the Course

- Dress code is similar to other clubs – **made-for-golf attire only** and soft soled shoes. Collared shirts to be tucked in. No active wear, cargo pants or shirts with large logos.
- If playing 18 holes play **blue/red** tees first, then **white/yellow** [**men/women**].
- Rakes are placed in bunkers pointing in line of play to the flag.
- Buggies may be taken across the greens.
- Repair divots on course and pitch marks on the greens.
- Return sand buckets to the stands provided.
- Toilet security code 5<sup>th</sup> fairway: C1913

### In the Clubhouse

- Any used cutlery, crockery and glasses are to be washed, dried and put away in the relevant cupboards.
- Dishwasher to be emptied, drained and turned off, with the racks stored inside. (Instructions are on the wall).
- Wet tea towels and soiled tablecloths to be placed in the laundry basket, next to the cleaning cupboard.
- Dry tea towels to be left on the rack under the sink.
- Benches wiped down.
- Dining tables replaced.
- Chairs re-stacked on the verandah or inside.
- BBQ cleaned if used (*cleaning gear is in the kitchen under the oven*).
- Recyclable rubbish (bottles, cans etc) to be placed in the recycle bins outside.
- Fire screen placed in front of fire.
